

## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE JERSEY CITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY HELD ON THE 21st DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2017



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The Board of Commissioners of the Jersey City Redevelopment Agency met in a Regular Meeting at the Agency office, 30 Montgomery Street, Jersey City, New Jersey on Tuesday, November 21st at 6:00 p.m., the place and date duly established for the holding of such Meeting. The Chairman called the Meeting to order at 6:11 p.m., and upon roll call the following answered present:

and the following were absent: DARWIN R. ONA. The Chairman thereupon declared a quorum present. Also present at the Meeting were David P. Donnelly, Executive Director; Christopher Fiore, Assistant Executive Director; Diana H. Jeffrey, Esq., General Counsel; Barbara Amato, Secretary to the Board and secretary for the Meeting; Jesamil Suazo, Account Clerk; Mary Pat Noonan, Senior Project Manager; Elizabeth Vasquez, Supervising Fiscal Officer; Benjamin Delisle, Director of Development; Sarah Goldfarb, Director of Policy and Research; Phil Orphanidis, Real Estate Manager; Robert Napiorski Project Assistant, Maria Aguilar Ambrossi, Paralegal Secretary, and those listed on the attached Attendance Sheet.

Immediately following the Pledge of Allegiance the Assistant Executive Director announced that in accordance with the "Open Public Meetings Act," a copy of the Public Notice was sent to the Jersey Journal and to the City Clerk for the public's review and information.

The Chairman indicated there were presentations. Mr. John Palumbo, from Decotiis, Fitzpatrick, Cole and Giblin, represented the applicant, Bates Street Redevelopment, LLC. Mr. Palumbo indicated that the applicant propose to construct a mixed use project to contain residential and retail components in the Bates Street Redevelopment Area. Mr. Palumbo informed the Board that the developer has developed in the Jersey Avenue Redevelopment Area, also known as Soho West, located in the northern section of downtown Jersey City. Mr. Palumbio indicated that the developer would like to develop in the southern section of downtown Jersey City. Mr. Dean Marchetto, from Manhattan Building Company, explained to the Board that the Redevelopment Area is an extension of the Van Horne Area. Mr. Marchetto proposed to recreate the grid in order to connect the Van Horne Area to the Bates Redevelopment Area by establishing the same architectural style.

The Chairman then acknowledged the second presentation. Heather Kumer, from Connell Foley Law Firm, represented the applicant, Ash Street Properties, LLC. Ms. Kumer indicated that the applicant desires to develop on 17-19 Ash Street, located in the Lafayette Park Redevelopment Area. Two options were presented to the Board. The first option will consist of an eight story building and the second option is a six story building. The eight story building will consist of 31 units and the six story building will consist of 25 units. Ms. Kumer informed the Board that 16% of the units will be considered affordable housing for both options. Mr. Richard Garber, from GRO

Architects, indicated that this development is an "exciting" project for the Bergen/Lafayette Redevelopment Area. Mr. Garber reiterated Ms. Kumer's explanation regarding the six story building.

The Chairman then acknowledged the public speakers. Matt Wielkotz and Steven Wielkotz, from Ferraioli, Wielkotz, Cerullo & Cuva, P.A., introduced the Agency's 2018 Budget which will be submitted to the State for review. Ronald Gardner, from Hodulik and Morrison, P.A, indicated the Budget has decreased in amount due to grant activities.

At this time the Board agreed to go into closed Session. Accordingly, the following Resolution was introduced and duly seconded:

Emerging from Executive Session, Counsel made it known that discussion involving litigation, contract negotiations and personnel took place. No formal action was taken.

The Chairman noted that the Commissioners should have received their Agenda packages and asked if there were any questions, additions or comments.
