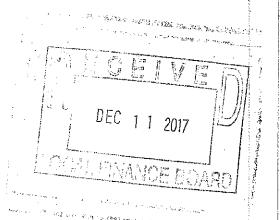

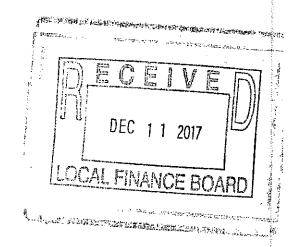

- The proposed budget decrease of \$2,479,936 or (21.1%) is largely due to a significant decrease in Federal grant funding.
- 2018 Administration Personnel Fringe Benefits appropriation increase by \$62,943 (or 13.8%)
 based on anticipated increases in health benefit rates during 2018.
- c. 2018 Administration Other Rent & Occupancy appropriations increased by \$19,166 (or 10.8%) based on rate increases on rental space for the Agency.
- d. 2018 Administration Other Professional & Legal appropriations increased by \$71,000 (or 23.7%) due to the anticipation of a need for increased legal services needed for a larger amount of redevelopment deals taking place during 2018 when compared to 2017.
- e. 2018 Administration Other Miscellaneous Administration increased by \$5,160 (or 22.1%) due to anticipated increases in related costs.
- f. Cost of Providing Services Other Comm Ed & Rec Cntr appropriations decreased by \$275,000 (or 100%) due to a change in accounting for this amount for budgetary purposes. These amounts are now classified as administration expenses during the current year due to an assessment by Management.
- g. Cost of Providing Services Other CDBG Development appropriation decreased by \$1,200,000 (or 66.7%) due to an anticipated decrease in funding by the Federal Government.
- h. Cost of Providing Services Other Grant Development Costs decreased by \$832,196 (or 12.0%) due to a decrease in anticipated grant funding from the Federal, State and Local grantors.
- Unrestricted Net Position Utilized Other increased by \$900,000 (or 100%) due to the fact that no unrestricted net position was utilized in the 2017 budget year.
