## **Clarifications:**

- 1. The Bid Opening Date is Thursday, September 4, 2025 at 11:00 AM.
- The proposed site work will be done under Emergency Authorization with the NJDEP. As a result
  it is anticipated site work will need to be completed within <u>120 days from mobilization</u>. The
  exact time period is pending NJDEP approval of the Emergency Authorization. If additional time
  is needed approval will be required from NJDEP.
- 3. Geotech Report prepared by Mueser Rutledge Consulting Engineers, dated August 15, 2024, has been included in the Hightail link (Attachment 21) https://spaces.hightail.com/space/reuOgLRnIH
- 4. A revised Price Form is attached to this Addendum 2. All respondents must use this updated version when submitting their bid.
- 5. Please note that means and methods for dewatering are to be determined by the Contractor. Line Item # 4 on the Price Form as been revised to "Stabilization and Dewatering".
  - The Contractor will be required to prepare and submit pre-construction submittals to the Owner, ECM and the Engineer, including a Sheeting & Shoring Plan (signed by a NJ Professional Engineer), if applicable.

#### Questions received by the JCRA and JCRA responses:

<u>Question 1:</u> Will the Uplands Remediation of the Mill Creek Property, soil disposal, be exempt from Hudson County Waste flow regulations?

<u>Response 1</u>: Per section 1 "Instruction to Bidders", Subsection 13 "Codes, Ordinances, and Regulations", the Contractor shall be responsible for adhering to all rules and regulations for the implementation of the scope of work.

Question 2: I believe when Addendum #1 was issued, there was a mention of Addendum #2 coming out. Is that going to happen?

<u>Response 2</u>: Addendum #2 will be posted by Thursday August 28<sup>th</sup>, with a Bid Opening Date set for Thursday, September 4, 2025 at 11:00 AM.

Question 3: The new bid date scheduled for September 4, 2025 kept the original time of 11:00 AM?

Response 3: Yes.

Question 4: The two link referenced in Addendum 1 are the only changes in the big as well as pages 8-13

<u>Response 4</u>: If the question being posed is confirmation of the changes presented in Addendum 1, please refer back to Addendum 1. Additional changes are noted within this Addendum 2.

<u>Question 5:</u> If there are specific disposal protocols, bid timelines, or coordination requirements with Argent or other stakeholders, I'd appreciate any guidance you can share.

<u>Response 5</u>: Refer to the bid documents for bid timelines. Refer to the technical bid specification for specific disposal protocols and coordination requirements.

Question 6: Please provide the restoration/landscape details for AOC B-4.

<u>Response 6:</u> Restoration will be consistent with the other excavations close to the SHWL – perennial/ground cover/ornamental grass mass.

Question 7: Please provide specifications for the demarcation geotextile.

Response 7: Any filter fabric that can act as a visual demarcation is acceptable.

Question 8: Please provide the construction detail drawings for the new gate/fence.

<u>Response 8</u>: There is no new update to the gate/fence from Addendum 1. Refer to Attachment 19 – Chain Link Fence and Gates, which has been added to the Hightail link:
